If you're a gay or bisexual man living with HIV, our +Pals group is a free, confidential space to socialise, build supportive connections, and share your experiences of things like disclosure, stigma, relationships and treatments.

Our +Pals staff are also HIV positive, so they understand the challenges of living with HIV and are happy to help. We meet twice a month: on the third Saturday in Wandsworth; while our second meet-up might be a visit to a museum or enjoying London's outdoor spaces.
